## **Church Wedding Coordinator**

The wedding coordinator serves as the liaison between the bridal couple and the church. Once the church office has confirmed the wedding date, the couple should call to schedule an appointment with the coordinator, to be held at the church. At this preliminary consultation, details of the ceremony and rehearsal will be discussed. A detailed walk through of the church to plan the use of the facilities would also be done at this time.

The coordinator is present at the rehearsal to supervise the formal, organized parts of the wedding, based on decisions made with the couple at the consultation. The coordinator instructs everyone as to the mechanics involved (where to stand, when to turn, how to usher, etc.). The coordinator supervises on the wedding date and assists the wedding party as needed. Working with the minister and organist, along with supervising the florist, photographer and any other special assistants, the coordinator will help insure that everything is the way you want it on your wedding day.
